
How to configure email on Android phone

Configuring your email

First you will want to open up your Gmail Application, and from there you you will see an option to "Add another account"


1. Open the mail app.



2. Select the 'Other' option.

- 3. Enter the email address you wish to connect to. In this example, the email is name@yourdomain.com.
- 4. Click the MANUAL SETUP button.








6. Enter your password.

- 7. Enter the following 'Incoming' server settings:
 - Username Your full email address
 - Password The password of your email address
 - o SERVER Place your websites URL here without WWW
- 8. Click the NEXT button.

The Outgoing server settings screen opens:

- 9. Enter the following 'Outgoing' server settings:
 - o USERNAME Your full email address
 - AUTHENTICATION Your password
 - o SMTP SERVER This should always be your websites URL

10. Click the NEXT button.

The Account options screen opens:

11. Select your desired settings.
